

## 2011 CARNIVALS

Want to enter your team in a district carnival? It can be both good fun and good practice for the team as they play 8-10 shortened competition matches on the one day.

To enter you will need:

- To **supply an umpire** for your team. The umpire must be capable of umpiring the grade and preferably a senior. Most Associations require badged umpires for finals, but you can usually find one there for the finals if you get that far. If you need help contact our Umpires Convenor. It is usual practice to pay the umpire a nominal fee for the day's effort. This is entirely up to the arrangement between the umpire and the team and is funded by the team.
- To **complete a carnival entry form and pay the entry fee** (non refundable). The entry fee for carnivals is \$22 per team and is to be funded by the team. An entry form (available from myself) is to be completed and returned to me together with the entry fee **AT LEAST 6 WEEKS PRIOR TO THE CARNIVAL DATE**. We need to register teams with SSNA 5 weeks prior to the carnival.
- Be prepared to get up early and be at the venue by 8.00am.

**Dates, venues and divisions for carnivals to be held will be notified soon.**

*Divisions are:*   **Modified:** 10 years  
                          **Juniors:** 11 & 12 years  
                          **Intermediate:** 13, 14 & 15 years  
                          **Seniors:** 16 years & over

Unfortunately our 8 and 9 yrs teams cannot play in district carnivals due the insurance scheme chosen by the SSNA. There will be a separate **Gala Day** held for the 8 and 9 yrs teams at Bellingarra, which is usually held in July.
